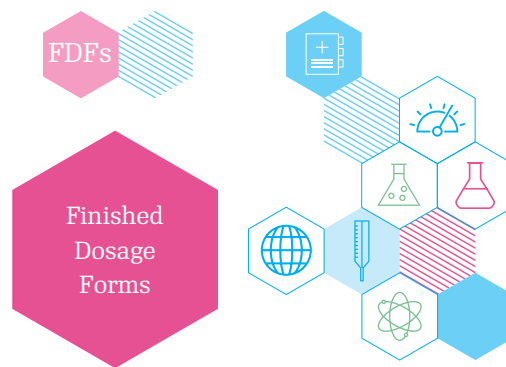


Micafungin vials



Micafungin* is a semisynthetic lipopeptide from the echinocandin class of antifungal agents. Micafungin is active against most isolates of the following *Candida* species such as *Candida albicans*, *Candida glabrata*, *Candida guilliermondii*, *Candida krusei*, *Candida parapsilosis* and *Candida tropicalis*.

Indication: Micafungin is indicated for the treatment of invasive candidiasis like blood stream *Candida* infections and disseminated candidiasis, esophageal candidiasis and for prophylaxis of *Candida* infections in patients undergoing hematopoietic stem cell transplantation and in patients at risk of neutropenia (EU).

Application: Administered by intravenous infusion.
